POLICY INTENT

To ensure that any employment opportunity website linked to the AUSU web-site satisfies the Objectives and Mission Statement of the union.

POLICY RESPONSIBILITY

Council

POLICY

- 7.04.01 All members in good standing should have equal access to any employment opportunity web-site linked to AUSU. Specifically, no fees should be charged to the members who wish to use the website to seek employment. Fees may be charged to employers.
- 7.04.02 AUSU must retain the ability to allow specific employers, including AUSU, the ability to place employment advertisements on the site free of charge.
- 7.04.03 Any fees collected by AUSU for the use of the site should be first directed into any costs AUSU incurs for operating the site, with the remainder directed toward the provision of additional awards and/or bursaries.
- 7.04.04 AUSU will strive to offer a wide range of employment options for its members, including, but not limited to, full-time, part-time, practicum, temporary, co-op and internship opportunities.
- 7.04.05 AUSU will strive to offer a range of services in addition to job listings, which may include resume help, interview tips, links to other job resources, etc.
- 7.04.06 If AUSU uses an external provider for the employment site, AUSU does not agree to accept liability for any actions or negligence of the external third party, and will place appropriate notices upon leaving the AUSU site.
