#### **POLICY**

WHEREAS program students must complete specific requirements to complete a degree program

WHEREAS assessing the fulfillment of degree requirements, especially when transfer credits are a factor, can be complicated and there is a high margin for error;

WHEREAS errors in program planning can result in students having to take additional courses and potentially extend their study period;

WHEREAS degree requirements can change from time to time, and students often need to fulfill requirements other than those of the current program revision;

AND WHEREAS students may wish to access information about their program progress outside of regular business hours or with less notice than an academic advisor may be able to accommodate;

BE IT RESOLVED THAT AUSU shall encourage Athabasca University to develop an electronic degree audit and program planning system to be accessible online.
