Log in Protocol: AUSU uses an on-line conferencing system. Go to <https://athabasca.pgimeet.com/AUSUCouncil>, If you have not used the system recently, you may get a screen with the account number and asking for a password. If so, click "(This is not me)", and in the next screen you should be asked for your name and email address. Enter those and click "Join Meeting". On the next screen you can either create your own individual password and click "Register", or you can click "Continue as guest" (small grey type below the orange "Register" button).

In a moment the "Connect Audio" box will pop up. Under the "Call My Phone" tab, enter your phone number and extension if applicable and click "Connect Me". The system will call your telephone for the audio component of the meeting. You can also connect audio through your computer but your speaker and microphone set-up may affect sound quality for you and other participants.

If, **and only if**, you do not have computer access for the meeting, you may join the audio only portion of the meeting by calling 1-877-806-9883 and entering the participant code 206869#. **Please do remember that any time you use this option you cost AUSU an extra per-minute fee.**
