Overview

In June 2016 AUSU circulated a survey about AUSU services to all current AUSU members.

There is some great feedback from this survey. The most notable results are that respondents generally felt in favor of AUSU services, with an average of 86% of respondents selecting "yes" (74%) or "maybe" (12%) in response to whether each AUSU service is useful.

However, the survey also indicated there is still low awareness about AUSU, with an average of **74%** of respondents being unaware of key AUSU services.

It is also apparent from some of the responses that there is confusion about what some of the services are, and in some cases, whether they are AU or AUSU services. This is particularly notable in the Awards & Bursaries and Course Evaluations section, as some responses clearly reference AU services. In addition, many students stated they do not get the AUSU newsletters, but the survey was sent to them via the newsletter. Several comments suggested we offer services or communications that AUSU already does, such as a welcome email for new students or emails sent to all students. Additionally, there were numerous comments about students not having access to AUSU services because they are an online student, so it is clear that some students do not realize that AU is an online university and that AUSU services are for all students.





Average Rating Per Service




Top Advocacy Concerns



Top Choices for AUSU to Focus On





Have you used this AUSU Service?




Do you think this is a useful Service?

Would you use this AUSU Service in the future?




Q1 Do you feel this is a useful service to offer to AUSU members?

Q2 Have you used the Student Lifeline program through AUSU?




Q3 Were you previously aware of the Student Lifeline program through AUSU?

Q4 Would you use the Student Lifeline program in the future?




Q5 How often have you accessed the Student Lifeline program?

Q6 Did you find the Student Lifeline program to be helpful?








Q9 Have you used the lynda.com feature through AUSU?

Q10 Were you previously aware of the free lynda.com subscription from AUSU?




Q11 Would you access lynda.com for free through AUSU in the future?

Q12 How often have you watched lynda.com training videos?



Q13 Did you find the lynda.com training to be helpful?






Q15 Have you requested access to the SmartDraw software through AUSU?

Q16 Were you previously aware of the free SmartDraw subscription from AUSU?




Q17 Would you use the SmartDraw program from AUSU in the future?

Q18 How often have you used the SmartDraw software?








Q21 Were you previously aware of The Voice Magazine?

Q22 Would you read it in the future?








Q27 Do you feel the Mobile App is a useful service to offer to AUSU members?




Q29 Were you previously aware of the Mobile App?

Q30 Would you use the Mobile App in the future?












Q35 Were you previously aware of AUSU's awards and bursaries?

Q36 Have you ever applied for an AUSU Scholarship, Award, or Bursary?



Q37 Do you feel that the award categories are adequate and representative of the AUSU membership?






Q39 Are you aware that AUSU is a member of the Canadian Alliance of Students Associations (a national student advocacy group otherwise known as CASA)?

Q40 Were you previously aware that you can contact AUSU with concerns you have concerns and need advocacy as an AU student?




Q41 Do you feel comfortable contacting AUSU with your concerns as an AU student?

Q42 Have you ever contacted AUSU with a concern you would like advocacy with?





Q44 What do you feel are the most important issues that AUSU should advocate for?






Q45 Do you think this is a valuable service to offer AUSU members at the cost of ~\$8 per Calendar, or ~\$4,000 per 500 Calendars.

Q46 Have you ever ordered an AUSU Calendar?




Q47 Would you ever order an AUSU Weekly Calendar in the future?

Q48 How often did you/do you use the calendar you ordered?



Q49 Would you order an AUSU weekly calendar again in the future?



Q50 Do you feel this is a useful service for AUSU members?




Q51 Have you filled out a course evaluation?

Q52 Would you fill out an AUSU course evaluation in the future?






Q54 Do you feel the AUSU course evaluation allowed you to adequately evaluate your course(s)?


Q55 Do you plan to complete course evaluations in the future?




Q64 Are you interested in attending an AUSU Meet & Greet in your area to meet other AU students in person?




Q67 AUSU would like to know which of our services are most important to you. Please rank the services below.


