2.0 Announcement of Election Results

The results of the 2016 AUSU By-Election were announced in accordance with AUSU Policy 3.01 Election Conduct.

The by-Election received 988 votes. The top two candidates who were elected to council are Amanda Lipinski and Robin Bleich.

A question was raised about the time and date of the October 13 council meeting. The meeting was briefly explained, as the new councillors will be sworn in to office during that meeting.

A question was raised about what platform AUSU used for the by-election, and whether or not future elections could use the Mobile App for the platform, or use a share-point interface on the AU site. The following discussion points were made:

- AUSU has already put the election discussion platform on our action list for investigation to find a better option for future elections.
- Requiring members to log into an out-sourced forum for the election discussions may impede engagement.
- The Mobile App was not used for the election platform as not all students have a mobile device, and AUSU felt it was important to use a desktop platform so all members had the option of participating. In addition, the only discussion platform in the Mobile App is the Campus Wall. Given that there were extensive discussions during the election, this would have taken over the entire Campus Wall just for the AUSU election, and the Mobile App is shared with AUGSA, the Grad Students' Association.
- AUSU can look into the option of a share-point interface on the AU site. However,
 AU and AUSU are completely separate organizations, and it would be difficult
 getting anything done that requires AU IT resources as they are very busy, and not
 obligated to assist with AUSU's elections.
- AUSU will keep the suggestions in mind while investigating better options for future elections, and welcomes feedback from the membership.

All candidates were thanked for their participation in the AUSU by-election.
