Athabasca University Students' Union (AUSU) has accepted the resignation of Councillor and VP Finance and Administration Brittany Daigle from AUSU council effective March 20, 2020.

Brittany Daigle was elected to AUSU council in the 2018 General Election and was elected as the AUSU VP Finance and Administration on May 22, 2019. As part of her role as the VP Finance and Administration, she also sat on the Athabasca University General Faculties Council (GFC) and various GFC subsidiary committees, as well as sat on Faculty Council for various faculties at Athabasca University.
