Qualifications

Post LPN-BN Clinical Committee

- Post LPN-BN program student who has completed a professional practice course or will do so in the term following appointment.
- Understanding of and commitment to Athabasca University's mission and values.

Roles & Responsibilities

- BN learner representative will liaise with the BN Clinical Committee as a key informant and representative of the student voice to promote positive change
- Prepare for the committee meetings (duration of approximately 1 to 3 hours) by reviewing the agenda package in advance of the meetings.
- The BN Clinical Committee Learner Representative shall commence yearly on January 1. The position is a one-year renewable term.

Time Commitment

- The role generally requires a commitment of 1 - 3 hours per clinical meeting (three times per year), this may fluctuate depending on reading/discussions necessary to be properly informed to participate in committee work.
- The role will additionally require approximately a 1hour commitment per three Town Hall Meetings per year
- An honorarium will be paid at \$50 per meeting including Town Hall.
