- **5.1** Opening of the floor to nominations

- **5.3** Allotted time for each candidate to present an election speech, not to exceed five (5) minutes per candidate. Candidates will be asked to speak in alphabetical order by last name.
 - L. Campbell provided her election speech.

- 5.4 Question period for nominees. Each Councillor will be limited to one question directed to each individual candidate and one question directed to all candidates. There will be a maximum of one minute allotted to ask each question and two minutes allotted to each answer. Question period may be extended at the chair's discretion if time allows.
 - S. Hutchings asked what motivated the candidates to run for council in the first place; L. Campbell replied advocacy for students; C. MacKay replied speaking on behalf of students with disabilities.
 - K. Fletcher asked about policy experience and time commitments; C. MacKay replied with high school and community experiences; L. Campbell replied with time flexibility.
 - N. Iwanek asked about what the candidates would like to accomplish as VPFA; C. MacKay replied with deeper understanding of AUSU; L. Campbell replied with policy development work.
 - A. McDuffe asked what flexibility and work-life balance might be required; L. Campbell replied occasional weeks might need less than 30 hours of work; C. MacKay feels confident going from 50 hours a week to 30 hours a week would be a better balance.
 - D. Syed asked about committee experience; L. Campbell replied with her experience with the AUSU budget; C. MacKay replied with the process of giving out awards on the Awards Committee.
 - K. Lowe asked about the strongest asset to the role; C. MacKay relied with her past experience with budgets; L. Campbell replied with past work with Brandon Police Department and at an accounting firm.
 - M. Charlton asked about work ethic; L. Campbell replied discussing her time management and experience; C. MacKay replied that she gives her all to positions she has had in the past.
 - R. Johnson asked what animal represents them; C. MacKay replied a dog; L. Campbell replied with a cat.
 - J. Crowchild-Fletcher asked about the TRC Calls to Action; L. Campbell and C. MacKay replied they are eager to do so.
